Challenges

- External Discovery Site (EDS) is part of Academic Analytics Discovery Suite, a robust set of business intelligence tools.
- EDS allows an institution to put its research information on a public-facing, external site.
- EDS combines Academic Analytics' data with a university's own warehoused data, which can include: faculty record systems, research expenditure data, course descriptions, faculty bios and profiles (that scholars can control), and postdoc and GRA positions available.
- This data can be made available to the public through an integrated, fully configurable user interface. This allows the public to search the institution's research portfolio and display information at the faculty, program, department or center level.
- Benefits of EDS for institutions include:
 - Showcases the institution's research portfolio and capabilities
 - Enables users to identify faculty experts in specific fields for possible research collaboration
 - Allows users to discover scholars based on topics of interest

- Exposes scholars' research externally, possibly leading to funding to support further research
- Attracts students with interest in a particular research area
